



South Course - Golf Hole Analysis

1st 353 yds. Par 4

This is a rather short length straight par 4. The fairway is wide and un-obstructed. It is bordered on the left by the practice course which plays out-of bounds. The right side of the hole is wide and slopes down to the bordering 7th hole. The approach is made to a green that is guarded by bunkers on both sides. The rear of the green is steeply sloped towards a wooded area.

2nd 323 yds. Par 4

This is a short, challenging par 4. The tee shot is blind to a down-hill sloping fairway. The left side of the hole is bordered by the practice course which is out-of bounds. The left and right side of the hole has some wooded areas. The approach is made to a large green that is surrounded by a pond.

3rd 318 yds. Par 4

This is a short, flat dog-leg-left par 4. The tee shot is slightly elevated to a wide, expansive fairway. The approach is made to a small green guarded by three bunkers and mounding.

4th 157 yds. Par 3

This is a scenic par 3 hole that is bordered on two sides by the Presumpscot River. The tee shot is to a long narrow green that is guarded by a large bunker on the right and mounding.

5th 302 yds. Par 5

This is a challenging, short par 4 that is bordered along the entire left side by the river. The tee shot is to a wide fairway that quickly narrows towards the green. The approach to the green is guarded on the right by a pond and a bunker to the rear of the green.

6th 540 yds. Par 5

This is a long par 5 that is bordered along the entire left side by the river, and on the right, an up-hill slope to a wooded area. The tee shot is made to a narrow fairway, followed by a second to a widening fairway. The approach is made to a long green nestled next to the river and guarded by two bunkers on the right.

7th 383 yds. Par 4

This is a medium length dog-leg-left par 4. The tee shot is made to a sloping fairway that is blind to the golfers. The fairway is located in a valley between the bordering 1st and 8th holes. The approach is made to a large green guarded by a bunker on the right and a steep ravine to the rear.

8th 160 yds. Par 3

This is a medium length par 3 that has the biggest green on the course. The green is guarded by large bunkers on each side.

9th 405 yds. Par 4

This is a long, slight dog-leg-right par 4 that borders the North Course. The left side of this hole is out of bounds and is outlined with mature pine trees. The tee shot is made to a medium width fairway and the approach is made to a green that is guarded on the left by a bunker and a steep ravine on the right.
